- Share PubMed citations with colleagues via a URL link
- Automatically alert team members when new research is published on a certain topic/author/paper
- Track your publications and see who has cited them
- Download hundreds of full-text articles with a mouse click and perform searches and cluster analyses within them
- Organize and share your bibliographies with colleagues
- Identify your *h*-index and the impact factor of journals.

BiomedExperts:

Search and analyze the literature-based profiles of over 1.8 million biomedical researchers from more than 190 countries.

Portal for Researchers:

Quick links to websites, databases and tools for human- and animal-based researchers at the University of Miami.

Portal for Collaboration/Mentoring:

Learn of databases, tools and UM-specific websites, online discussion lists and groups that promote and facilitate collaboration and mentoring.

SciVal Experts (formerly Collexis):

Quickly identify UM biomedical collaborators and mentors from their profiles, created from their PubMed citations and NIH-funded research projects.

QUOSA Information Manager:

Download, manage and search full text articles in minutes – not hours or days – from MEDLINE and SCOPUS.

RefWorks:

Rapidly download article citations, insert citations into your Word document, and format your bibliography in nearly any style.

PubMed's

collaborative features:

Save selected citations to your Collections and send colleagues a link to it.

Create an AutoAlert so you'll know when new articles are published on your topic.

CINAHL's & PsycINFO's

collaborative features:

Save selected citations to a permanent folder in your account and email those citations to colleagues.

Create an AutoAlert so you'll know when new articles are published on your topic.

SCOPUS and Web of Science:

Find articles that have cited your or others' articles, learn the journal's Impact Factor (WoS), and an author's *h*-index (Scopus). Create an AutoAlert on an article, author or topic.
